The Swedish Freedom of the Press Act Unfolded

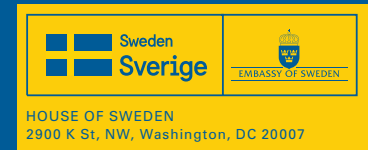
