**THE SASS SWEDISH TRAVEL GRANT**

- From:** The Consulate General of Sweden in New York
- Award:** Travel grant of up to \$1000 for study of or research in Swedish language, literature, cultural studies or social sciences.
- Eligible:** Open to the general public of the United States, with priority given to members of the Society for the Advancement of Scandinavian Study (SASS) and, in particular, to graduate students and untenured faculty. Grants may be used for projects in either Sweden or North America.
- Deadline:** October 15      **Notification:** November 10

- Date and place of birth, citizenship
- Duration, place and approximate dates for use of grant
- Present occupation
- Educational background
- Language proficiency in Swedish
- Previous studies abroad: where, when and why
- Other grants applied for/received for this project
- Two references from persons who can comment on your project and your ability to achieve it, sent directly to the address below
- Detailed outline, including budget, stating specific goals of your study or research project
- Your signature and the date of the application

**A short report evaluating achievement of the goals stated in the application must be submitted to the Consulate General of Sweden in New York within six months of the completion of the project.**
