An academic travel grant in the amount of 1000 USD in support of study or research in Swedish literature, culture or social sciences. The grant is open to all residents of the United States, with priority given to members of the Society for the Advancement of Scandinavian Study and, in particular, to graduate students and untenured faculty.

**Deadline: April 15, 2008 (for travel during the academic year of 2008-09)**

APPLICATIONS SHOULD FOLLOW THE OUTLINE BELOW:

- Name, address, telephone numbers (work and home)
- Date and place of birth, citizenship
- Duration, place and approximate dates for use of grant
- Present occupation
- Educational background
- Language proficiency in Swedish
- Previous studies abroad: where, when and why
- Other grants applied for/received for this project
- Two references from persons who can comment on the project and the applicant's ability to achieve it, sent directly to the address below
- Detailed outline, including budget, stating specific goals of the study or research project
- Applicant's signature and the date of the application
