Overview and objectives

Based on assumptions that when Liberian civil society actors regularly network and share information in a structured manner, discussions on sexual and reproductive health and rights (SRHR) will be advanced nationally. RFSU's intervention will provide awareness on SRHR issues as well as capacity building to strengthen civil society actors in this area.

The programme aims to stimulate a Liberian civil society movement to ensure that all people in Liberia are free to decide over their bodies and sexualities regardless of power and wealth.

The programme outcomes target Liberian civil society organisations to ensure that CSOs:

- have advanced SRHR,
- Increase knowledge and awareness about bodily autonomy, sexuality, and rights among Liberia youth, women and LGBTI people as well as relevant stakeholders, and
- become vocal in claiming SRHR.

Activities

RFSU will address building and strengthening the capacity of local civil society organisations and develop a network that will lead the following activities: sexuality education to a broad public through the media and campaigns • develop knowledge in society, in relevant institutions and actors by training professionals in healthcare, schools, the justice system, civil society and other relevant parts of society • Evidence based national policy advocacy and accountability work towards policymakers at national and county level, including follow-up of accepted UPR(**Universal Periodic Review**) recommendations. • SRHR knowledge provided to relevant stakeholders.
