Minors under 18 years old - only under special circumstances where the applicant is not required to show uperson, the application can be submitted through a third party with completed and signed power of attorney for the applicant's legal custodian in Swedish/English stating the purpose required. Copy of ID must be provided for the third party together with power of attorney. This only applies to minors who were already above 12 years when they left their fingerprints for a Schengen visa application and was granted the visa. Applications cannot submitted through a third party for minors between the age of 0-12 years.			
Only applicable if biometrics has been obtained within the last 59 months and new biometrics is submitted. VFS has informed me that it is voluntary to submit new biometrics, but I still choose to do so.			
I decided to submit my application even though there are lacking documents. If missing documents are not submitted within one day after submission, application might be decided on the existing documents submitted.
